Frequently Asked Questions

Why are questions slanted toward Catholics?

The requirements for the Rosary Patch were initially written for Scouts and Scouters registered with the Boy Scouts of America to celebrate the Year of the Rosary. However, the program is open to everyone interested in attaining the patch.

Can Christian youth registered in Girl Scouts or Camp Fire relate to these questions?

Yes. The questions are taken from the Bible describing the birth, ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus and in some cases the biblical reference is made.

Is the Rosary Patch considered a Religious Emblem, and will Cub or Boy Scouts receive their Religious Knot after completing the form?

No. The Rosary patch is considered a Religious Activity not a Religious Emblem. Cub and Boy Scouts will not receive a Religious Knot after completing the form.

Will there be more than one Rosary Patch?

Yes. There are a series of five patches. They run as follows: Joyful Mysteries Patch; Luminous Mysteries Patch; Sorrowful Mysteries Patch; Glorious Mysteries Patch and the Rosary Patch. All patches are still available.

The Rosary Patch Series has focused on the different Mysteries of the Holy Rosary and Pray the Rosary. This is an opportunity for youth and adults alike to learn more about their faith. All youth and adults are eligible to earn the patch. It is not necessary to send the completed form. Adults can verify the correctness of the answers. Each patch will cost \$4.00.

Requirements for 1st thru 5th grade (Answer 5 of 10 questions)

2. Who betrayed Jesus and how did he do it? (Luke 22: 47-49)
3. Why did Pilate ask Jesus who He was?
4. What did Jesus answer?
5. What is a Crown of Thorns and why was it placed on Jesus' head?
6. What did the crowd of people keep shouting?
7. When He carried the cross, how many times did He fall?
8. How many thieves were crucified with Jesus?
9. What did the sign of Jesus' cross say? (Luke 23:38)
10. Where was He buried?

Requirements for 6th thru 12th grade (Answer 5 of 10 questions)

1. Who betrayed Jesus?
2. What sign did he give to the soldiers? (Matt 26: 47-49)
3. How much was he paid to betray Jesus?
4. Why did the soldiers beat Jesus?
5. What is a crown of thorns?
6. How many times did Peter deny Jesus?
7. Who was forced to help carry the cross? (Luke 23: 26)
8. What did one of the thieves ask of Jesus? (Luke 23: 40-42)
9. What did Jesus respond?
10. What were Jesus' last words? (Luke 23: 46)

Requirements for Adults (Answer 5 of 10 questions)

1. At the Last Supper, did Jesus know who was going to betray Him? (Luke 22: 21-23)
2. What did Jesus ask of God in the Garden of Gethsemane? (Luke 22:39-44)
3. What did Jesus say to Peter about denying Him? (Luke 22: 31)
4. Why was Jesus being beaten and scourged?
5. What did Pilate's wife say about Jesus? (Matt 27: 19-24)
6. Why did the soldiers force Simon to carry the cross for Jesus?
7. What did Jesus say to the daughters of Jerusalem?
8. What sacrament was Jesus referring to when He asked His Father to forgive the people?
9. What happened on earth when Jesus died? (Matt 27: 50-53)
10. Who requested the body of Jesus for burial?
